- members at our location travel frequently but only 1-3 weeks at a time, so this doesn't really benefit spouses at this location


Academic Program

- We have no children



Can you suggest any other PSP morale and welfare program(s) that could be funded through the European Fund? Keep in mind it must be open to all European Fund members.


- I would like to get more info on rebates and programs as it sounds like there is more than what I am aware of.
