

COMMUNITY RECREATION AQUATICS – PETAWAWA COVID-19 PROTOCOLS



ADMISSION / FACILITY INFORMATION

Location/Time:

- Participants will enter/exit the building by the designated door at the main entrance area of Dundonald Hall.
- All participants must arrive in their swimsuits.
- Participants can only enter the building by the designated entrance 10 minutes before their scheduled program.
- Participants must depart the facility within 10 minutes of the end of their scheduled program.



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Garrison Petawawa Online Screening Questionnaire:

- Participants and staff will complete the [Garrison Petawawa Online Screening Questionnaire](#) honestly and PRIOR to arriving at the facility.
- One screening result per family, per day.
- Participants will show the result of their screening questionnaire upon arrival.
- Stay home if you, or members of my household, experienced any COVID-19 symptoms and/or travelled outside of Canada within the last 14 days.
- Participants and staff who are exhibiting symptoms of illness will not be permitted into the facility.



Temperature Checks:

- Participants and staff will be screened and have to complete a temperature check before being permitted to enter the facility.
- Those with temperatures at or above 37.8C or 100 F will not be admitted.



Hand Hygiene:

- All persons accessing the facility will be required to have good hand hygiene and wash their hands with hand sanitizer (provided at the entrance of the building) for 20 seconds.



Register:

- All persons accessing the facility will be required to sign the register upon entry.



Waivers:

- On the first day of programming, participants (or parent/guardian if the participant is a minor) must sign a waiver.
- If the waiver is not signed, the participant will not be able to enter the facility and will not access the program.



Changerooms:

- Participants must keep their belonging to a minimum.
- Access to changeroom will be limited:
 - Occupancy rates are reduced to allow physical distancing
 - Some sinks, toilets, and showers are decommissioned in order to allow physical distancing.
 - Lockers are not available for use – there is limited space at each assigned meeting area for participants to keep some of their belonging on deck.
- Participants must take a warm soapy shower before entering the pool area. Please note that participant do not have access to showers after their program.
- Follow the arrows in the changerooms.
- Users are asked to disinfect the bench/change table that they used in the changeroom (disinfecting wipes will be supplied at each bench).

HEALTH & SAFETY

Masks:

- Masks must be worn by participants while in the facility, waiting for lessons and after exiting the pool (but not in the water).
- For more information about masks please consult the [COVID-19 Directive for Masks/Face Coverings](#) from the Renfrew County and District Health Unit.



Physical Distance:

- Registration will be available online only.
- Participants must maintain a physical distance of 2m from other participants and staff.
- In the event that the 2m distance cannot be kept due to extenuating circumstances (i.e. when receiving first aid treatment), the participant receiving the first aid treatment is to wear a mask. The staff member providing first aid treatment will wear a mask, face shield and gloves.



Cleaning and Sanitizing:

- Staff will disinfect:
 - equipment/writing utensils
 - high touched areas
 - changerooms
 - the designated meeting area
- The user will disinfect:
 - the bench that they used in the changeroom with a disinfecting wipe (provided at each bench) and discard the used wipe in the garbage bin.



Safe Arrival and Release and Attendance of Children:

- Participants in Parented Programs:
The participant is accompanied by one parent/guardian (16 years old or older) throughout their entire time in the facility.
- Participants in Non-Parented Programs:
 - Before the program
 - The participant is accompanied by one parent/guardian (16 years old or older) to the lobby of Dundonald Hall to show the child's screening result and sign-in. After the child has passed the admission screening, the parent leaves the building immediately. A staff member will be there to help direct the child.
 - After the lesson
 - The parent/guardian will sign the sign-out form at the lobby of Dundonald Hall. Then, they will wait for their child outside of the facility.
 - A staff will ensure safe release.
